



Internship MENA Programme 2020

The Middle East and North Africa (MENA) programme at the Swedish Institute of International Affairs (UI) is currently looking for an intern for the autumn semester 2020. See information about the programme, and how to apply below.

The MENA programme conducts research, analysis and activities focusing on the region's political, economic, and social conditions. Two areas are of particular interest: conflict management and geopolitics, and socio-economic development. More concretely, the programme deals with conflict management in the Persian Gulf and societal changes in countries within the MENA region. For the autumn 2020, the programme is recruiting an intern who, under the supervision of programme staff, will work on these themes.

Applicants

Applicants should be in the final stages of their study programme or be part of a labour market policy programme. The internship is unpaid. The duration of the internship should be around 20 weeks and must start during the autumn semester. The exact timeframe will be settled between the intern and the Swedish Institute for International Affairs.
